**Sec. 3.2.B. The Provisional Staff**

- B. At the end of this two-year period, each member of the provisional Medical Staff will be evaluated by the department in which he has privileges and the results of this evaluation will be submitted to the Credentials Committee and the Executive Committee. If this member is not eligible for advancement to the active staff, his provisional period may be extended for one year. At the end of this period, re-evaluation of his status will be made. If, at the end of this period he does not qualify for advancement, the provisional staff member will lose his membership and privileges on the Medical Staff. This recommendation for denial of advancement will result in loss of membership on the Medical Staff and will entitle the practitioner to the procedural rights in accordance with Article 7 of these bylaws for a determination of whether he should be advanced or lose his membership on the Medical Staff. Contract physicians are exempted from this provision and may remain on the provisional staff for an indefinite period of time.
